

Check for Visa requirements

Whether you need a visa or not is dependent on your country of citizenship. Most passport holders are eligible for a visa on arrival at no cost. However, others may need to apply for a visa beforehand. Academic Families will arrange all student trip visas.

We recommend that the passport used for your child's study visa and travel is valid for 6 months after their departure from the UK - so until the end of 2025. They will need at least one full blank page per country they visit during their time in the UK.
