Staying with a British family

Airports & transfers

Once you've arranged your child's international flights we will arrange their UK transfers including Unaccompanied Minor check-in and collection. We can help make your child's travel less stressful by arranging their transfer between the airport and school, either with school transport or one of our approved drivers.

We like our drivers to get to know our students, so we encourage them to chat and make sure your child is happy with their travel plans. Whenever possible, we'll organise the same driver for all your child's journeys. All our drivers are carefully selected and screened as well as being friendly, reliable and very good at sorting any luggage or check-in issues!

We can go further than check-in – we can go airside!

Airports can be confusing for young people, especially after a long flight. Our Airport Assistance service can ease their journey by escorting them airside and landside.

Arrivals - meet your child at the plane door and escort them through the airport (including Passport Control, changing terminals, shops and eateries) and hand them over to their driver or departure gate airline staff if they have an onward flight. **Departures** - meet your child at their taxi, check them in and escort them airside; handing them over to airline staff to board the plane. Our Airport Assistance service is also available to family members, especially those who are not confident English speakers.

Language support

We understand how important it is for you to communicate effectively with us and school. Not all our parents can communicate proficiently in English and you may prefer to communicate in your own language.

We can support you in Mandarin, Spanish, French, Dutch and Italian and will try to find an interpreter in your language if required. There's a fee for this additional service but it proves to be invaluable when required.

Our interpreters also ensure that school staff understand any cultural and language differences and will give their feedback on your child's progress.



Pastoral & academic support

We will be your school's point of contact for any issues relating to your child's care, safeguarding and education. Our extensive experience supporting families with a wide range of pastoral and academic concerns, ensures that you and your child will have the backup and guidance required until all is well again. And because we understand that you can't always be here in person, we can attend the annual Parents' Meeting on your behalf when teachers give their feedback on your child's progress.



Short courses

If you'd like to give your child an introduction to boarding life before they start school in September, then our pre-sessional courses are a great fit. We can also help you choose revision courses for UK exams in a variety of subjects, offered year-round. And if your child can't make it home for summer, they can benefit from one of our summer programmes focusing on a new skill or simply having fun!
